THE CONGRESS

The congress features four concurrent conferences covering upstream (plantation, agronomy, entomology, planting materials, genomics), midstream (processing, mechanisation, by-products and waste management, biomass), downstream and value addition (food, food safety, personal care, industrial applications, active compounds) and global economics and marketing.

The Henri Fauconnier Lecture that is the keynote address of the congress will be delivered by distinguished expert in the oil palm industry. Four plenary lectures representing four conference areas are scheduled on the first day of event, in line with the theme of the congress.

The main objectives of the congress are:

- to discuss strategic R&D findings in all spectrums of the oil palm and palm oil industry worldwide;
- to introduce recent technologies relevant to the oil palm/palm oil industry; and
- to formulate strategies towards enhanced sustainability, competitiveness, trade policies and market acceptance.

WHAT'S NEW IN PIPOC 2025

PIPOC 2025 retains the new conference structure as introduced in PIPOC 2023 with four simultaneous conferences namely Agriculture, Biotechnology and Sustainability (ABS); Downstream and Value Addition (DVA); Global Economics and Marketing (GEM) and rebranding of the Milling, Processing and Biorefinery (MPB).

Nutrition papers will be taken out of the DVA framework and will be discussed separately in the Nutrition Satellite Symposium which will be held on **17 November 2025** at the Conference Hall 2 (Level 3) Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre. This is to encourage more participation and intense discussions among experts and stakeholders of their area of interest.

On the same day, The International Seminar on Advancing the Next Generation of Oil Palm Planting Materials, organised by the International Society for Oil Palm Breeders (ISOPB) and MPOB will take place at the Impiana Hotel, Kuala Lumpur.

In addition, the first International Conference on Oil Palm Protection (ICOPP) will be held right after PIPOC 2025 on **21-22 November 2025** at the Berjaya Times Square Hotel, Kuala Lumpur to allow in depth discussions on oil palm diseases, pest and control.

THE VENUE

Situated at the heart of Kuala Lumpur's central business district, the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC) is the city's most technologically advanced, purpose-built facility for international, regional and local conventions, trade shows, public exhibitions, entertainment and private functions. 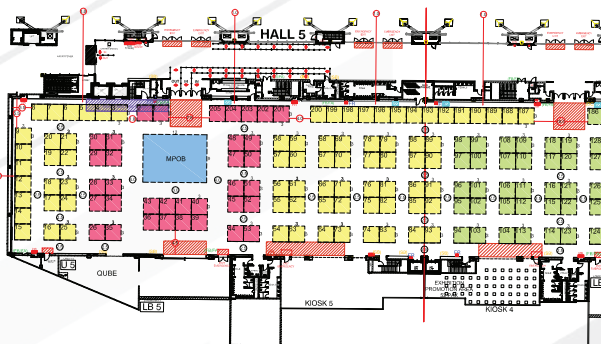

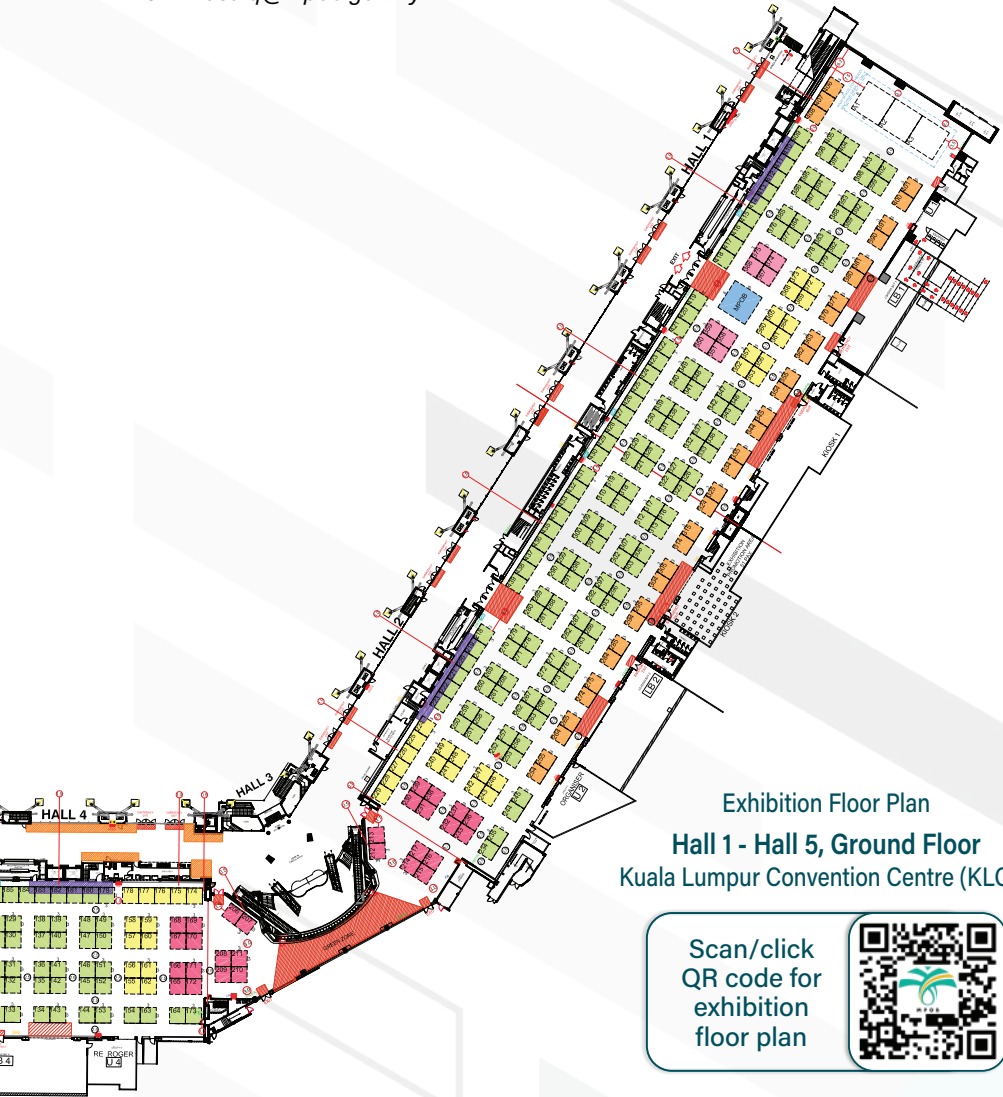
